

STAMPS FOR UMCOR

This on going stamp project started in 1982. From the beginning through 2015 UMCOR (United Methodist Committee On Relief) has received well over \$4,000 from funds received from canceled stamps.

Methodist women have been faithful in bringing stamps to UMW events.

The stamps are sold to a York River District stamp collector and distributor. The receipts for stamp sales are sent to the Conference Treasurer for distribution through UMCOR.

All cancelled stamps (except bulk mail stamps) are accepted, foreign stamps are usually more valuable.

Important: Cut or tear at least a 1/4 inch border around the stamp. Do not peel it from the envelope. Leave rows of stamps intact. Place cut stamps in a bag or envelope.

Please DO NOT mix stamps with collected soup or box top labels as they are for different missions and go to separate locations.

E-mail has lowered the number of stamps that are being saved. It is very important you save ALL the canceled stamps you receive, bag them, then send to the Charlottesville District treasurer or bring them to any Conference or District UMW event.

It is amazing how much we can "glean" from just little pieces of paper that would otherwise be thrown into the trash!

You can make a difference with very little effort.....
