









Emanuel YOUTH Mission: We have been working for 11 years to raise the standard of living for the families of Taura, El Salvador and other nearby rural communities, so these children and youth can finally break the chain of poverty that has been their way of life for generations. God and all of you, our mission partners, have made it possible for them to have their first church building, motorized vehicle for transportation, clean water, a medical clinic, irrigation to extend the growing season for these people who depend upon agriculture for their survival, fogging for mosquito control, shoes, clothing, food, and education. **Education is the best way to overcome poverty**.





These children are the first in their families to attend school. The school year begins in January; they do their school shopping in December, so we are asking for sponsorships now. **Please help these children** know they can begin school in January. **Sponsorship for one year per student is \$300.** Some students are graduating from high school and have the academic potential to go to college. **We need your help to sponsor these children for education and some for college.**

One year of college in El Salvador is \$5,000.

Yanci was our first high school graduate. She is passionate about being a doctor to help her people. Calvary Baptist Church in Lovingston, Virginia sponsors her for college, and we have opened a fund toward her medical school. She is already excelling. Here are
