The theme this year is Nature Based Solutions for Water. Our mission clean water system costs an average \$2,685 per month to maintain and deliver clean water to 15 communities. This is another necessity for the children.

We hope that reading this newsletter brings some sunshine into your cold winter days and into your hearts.
